
WALK 4 GUIDE --- 5 km (3 miles)

This is a short circular walk to the east of the village using public rights of way, tracks and pavements alongside roads. It can be started and finished either at the Horseshoe Inn or the General Elliot.

1a. If joining from the Horseshoe Inn, turn right out of the car park and then right on to Lord Street. Walk 150m and turn right into Abbey Close.

Or

- 1b. If joining from the General Elliot, turn right out of the car park on to Lord Street. After 100m, cross the road and enter Abbey Close.
- 2. Take the footpath to the left behind Deacons Close and walk through a 'tunnel' of hedges.
- 3. As you leave this path, continue straight ahead through the field between the 2 small woods towards the yellow top signpost.
- 4. Turn left and after 20m. turn right through a narrow gap towards the road.
- 5. Cross the 2 stiles and turn left on Lady Lane.
- 6. After 400m. cross the road and enter Gosling Park (Emerald Drive)
- 7. After 50m. turn right through the A-Frame and walk through the woods.
- 8. After 200m take the right hand fork along the path to the top pond
- 9. The path loops round an open meadow re-joining the path through the woods returning to the A-Frame.(A series of information boards are found here explaining the history of the site, it's ecology and a plan of the development.)
- 10. Turn left on to Emerald Drive and then right on to Lady Lane.
- 11. At the T- Junction, turn left on to Mustard Lane, cross the road and take the footpath returning to the village centre either to the General Elliot or to the Horseshoe Inn.
