## THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (CROSS LANE & LADY LANE, CROFT) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of driving as follows: Cross Lane from its junction with Warrington Road to its junction with Lady Lane; Lady Lane from its junction with Cross Lane to its junction with Mustard Lane. The Order will be effective from 20<sup>th</sup> November 2023 for 12 weeks, as and when signed on site. The works will be carried out in phases, Phase 1 Cross Lane and Phase 2 Lady Lane, with only one phase being implemented at any one time. Access will be under the control of the relevant Contractor for the duration of the works. The alternative routes will be as follows: Cross Lane via Warrington Road, Glaciers Lane, Wigshaw Lane, Mustard Lane and vice versa; Lady Lane via Cross Lane, Warrington Road, Glaciers Lane, Wigshaw Lane, Mustard Lane and vice versa and via New Lane, Smithy Lane, Lord Street, Mustard Lane, and vice versa.
